

RENT HELP RESOURCES

City of Richmond Eviction Diversion Program

Provides financial assistance to pay past due rent to landlords.

Only available to residents who rent in the City of Richmond.

- Requires landlord's participation
- Resource that provides help to bring a tenant's outstanding rent to a zero balance within three months or less
- Must have a court date and pay at least 35% on the hearing date
